




Our web-site activities page has been updated. Check it out often as events can change and new events are added. We have a great line up of events so I hope you all can join in on the fun.

## Well, now what? (Our Own Dave Ritchie is the new National CLC President; Congratulations Dave!)



Just want to tell you a little about myself and my background as a car guy, specifically a Cadillac car guy. I live in Tempe, Az., a suburb of Phoenix, but lived the first 20 years of my life in Pittsburgh. The bitter cold and snow caused me to re-think my future and directed me to head out west where I put down roots in sunny Arizona. What's not to like about a pool float and margaritas in January?

In 1967, it was off to Phoenix College, then to Arizona State University for a degree in Environmental Design, which led me to my first career in landscape architecture. I have been at this job for 30-plus years now; it's an outdoor thing (see above, pool float...).

When the money started pouring in, I needed a hobby. As a car guy since the fifth grade, hiding a *Rod & Custom* magazine in my textbook, the stage was set. I wanted to become a practicing car guy. I purchased my first future collectible —a gold 1966 Ford Thunderbird Landau. My next purchase was a white 1965 Ford Thunderbird Coupe. What was I thinking? I'm a GM car guy, not an "F"-word car guy.

My father, a funeral director in Munhall, Pa., always used Cadillacs in the business. The first was a black 1954 Fleetwood Sedan, then a black 1958 Sedan de Ville, and, best of all, a gray 1961 Fleetwood Sedan. I loved that gray Fleetwood. I took my driver's test in that Cadillac and drove it to my senior prom at Pittsburgh's Golden Hilton Hotel.


There she was, in *Auto Trader* magazine, a 1953 Series 62 Coupe, white with red interior, my very first Cadillac, which I referred to as the "Mayflower." Other Cadillacs that became part of the collection were a white 1953 Series 62 Convertible, white 1958 Eldorado Seville, white 1961 Coupe de Ville and white 1961 Fleetwood Sedan. The two 1961 cars matched, white with rose interior; after all, I am a design guy. I bought the 1961 Fleetwood in 1987, restored it and presented it to my mom for Mother's Day in 1988 at a local car show; the TV coverage was not quite what I expected....Unfortunately, I was sick with the 24-hour flu. Mom loved that car and drove it until 2002. This Cadillac is listed as CLC Senior No. 133, awarded at the 1992 Grand National Meet in Phoenix.

I joined the CLC in 1985, before there was an Arizona CLC Region. My second career began in 1990, at the first CLC Grand National I attended, in Carson City, Nev. During the board meeting, I raised my hand and became the first chairman of Membership Promotions. Chairman of Public Relations was added when I missed a meeting. I relinquished both positions in 2002. I started with 4,000 members and finished with 7,000, with the help of many dedicated members. I've served at the National board level since that fateful hand-raising, and helped found the Grand Canyon Region (1988) in Phoenix, the Sonoran Desert Region (1992) in Scottsdale, and the Saguaro Region in Tucson. I also developed the Newsletter Award program, Life Membership program and the concept for Chapters. I'm a past Southwest Regions vice president and also won the Mary Lou Evans Membership Award. They say, "No good deed goes unpunished." Today finds me serving on the CLC National board as president. I don't know what the future may hold, but boy, do I ever look forward to it. Great cars, great club, and most of all, great people in the Cadillac & LaSalle Club. See you in America.



Tom Hamilton bought the '56 Cadillac Coupe DeVille at the Mecum auction in Seattle in June.

"I wasn't necessarily looking to buy a car, but as my son, Houston and I were perusing the sales inventory, this one caught our attention."

I had a conversation with the seller and the story he told led me to the auction stage and ultimately to own the car.

The original owner, from the East Coast, died in 1962. In his will, he bequeathed the Cadillac to his nephew who had always admired it in Everett, Washington. On receiving the "baby blue" auto, he had it painted black.

As I tell people, "the bad news is that the color is not original; the good news is it's black."

The car was driven and pampered until 1977 (last WA license tabs) when it was retired to a carpeted, heated garage with just 32,000 miles on the clock. The car was maintained, run and kept clean and covered for the next 35 years. The consigner bought it from the nephew's widow in 2012.

As we speak, the car has 32,800 miles on it. The 50-year old quality paint job, which is obviously multiple coats of lacquer, looks like a "Grand Piano". A testament to the care the car was given over its lifetime.

Oh yes, after the sale at the auction block, the car was moved to another stage where Houston and I, with the seller were interviewed for an upcoming segment of Mecum's new "reality" show called "Deal Maker". Keep an eye out for us. They said it would air sometime in August or September 2014.

I have always had an interest in cars. I have owned new Aston Martins, Jags, and a Viper which I still have in AZ. But I just started collecting "classics" in the last years. In addition to the '56 Caddy, I have a '65 Coupe DeVille, a '63 Fleetwood and a '65 Olds 98 convertible. Yes, I'm always looking.

My wife Lynn and I met on top of Mt. Baldy in Sun Valley Idaho in the spring of 1985. I was in the snow ski business and living in the Seattle area where I was born, raised and had gone to school. Lynn was visiting with a girlfriend from her hometown of Dallas. After a long-distance love affair and tens of thousands of United Airlines miles, we were married in January 1988. Lynn moved to Seattle with her 3 sons (Zachary, Devin and John).. We were soon blessed with twin boys (Hunter and Houston) who are now 25 years old and both lieutenants; Hunter in the Army and Houston in the Washington State National Guard.

I enjoyed a 35-year career in the snow ski arena; racer, coach, instructor and 30 years in sales and marketing. I had a yearlong marketing consultant client who owned an Indy (CART) race team.



# Be Informed!

*A Message from Legislative Liaison Marvin Price*



There is not much movement in the legislative area this summer. Most of the politicians are busy campaigning for the fall elections. They want to keep their jobs of telling us what to do.

Arizona seems to be committed to establishing toll roads. And is moving forward with the process.

The AAHC will renew their effort to get the toll road issue on the 2016 Ballot after the fall election.

The number of signatures required to get the No Toll Road issue on the ballot is determined by the number of votes cast in the Governors election this fall. If voting for the Governor is light, than less than the current 200,000 Signatures may be required.

Arizona enacted a law effective June 1, 2014, that changes the number of cars an individual can sell from 3 to 5 before being considered a Dealer.

Around the country it is now illegal to distribute, sell or install lead wheel weights in the following states: Minnesota, California, Illinois, New York, Maine, Vermont and Washington. It probably won't be too long before Arizona will try to keep us safe from lead wheel weights.

Be sure to VOTE in both the Primary election and the Fall General Election.

These elections are the principal way we have to express our opinion of our political leadership.



You can submit video as long as you give me permission to transfer it to VIMEO or YOUTUBE in order to upload it into the newsletter template.






